Achieve

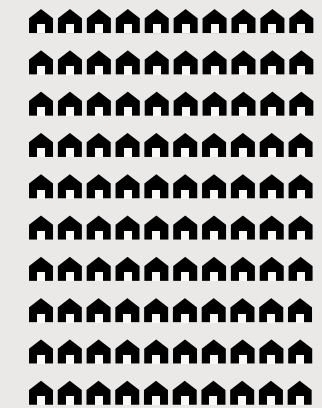

ReStore can provide you with a tax receipt or acknowledgment.

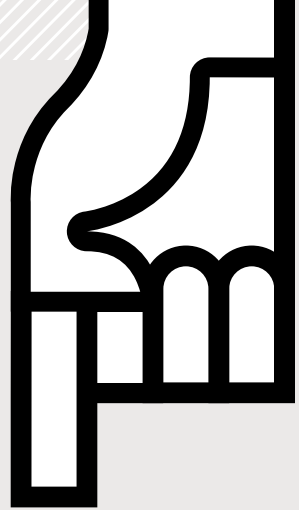

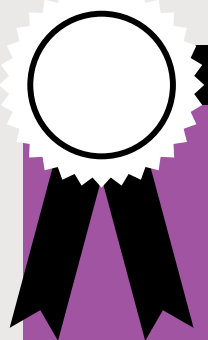
